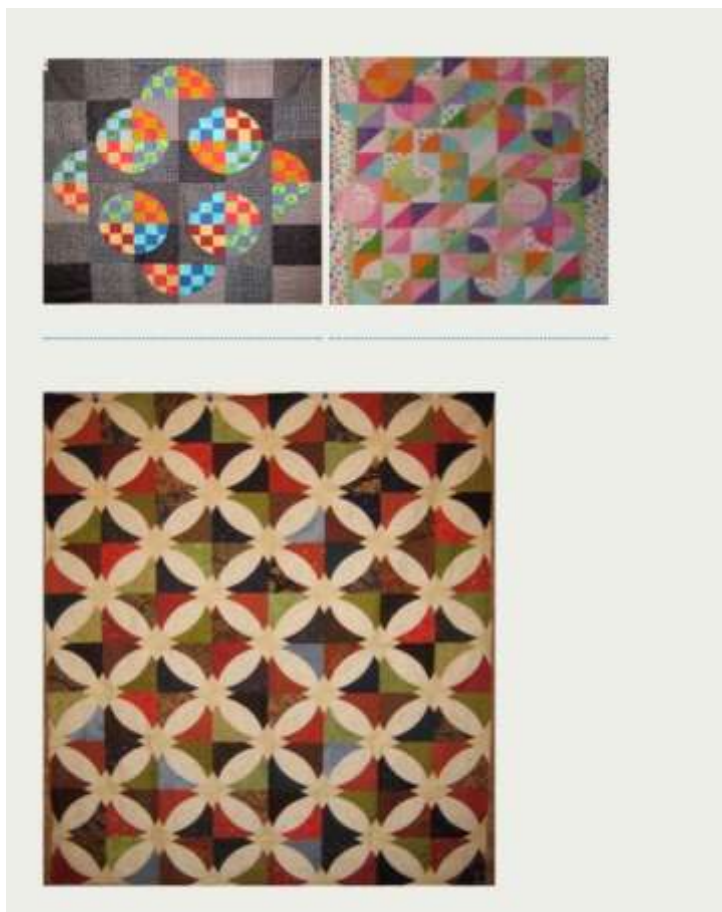

CCQ August 19th Workshop

The July charity workshop was a huge success! Thanks to the 15 sewers and many helping hands layering, pinning, turning, and pressing; we were able to get all 93 baby quilts sewn around and even got some quilted. The remaining quilts went home with several ladies to finish. Not only quilts got done, but we had a very industrious group of ladies cording bead bags. They were able to finish 125!! WhooHoo! Well done all!! I delivered 50 of the baby quilts to Family Outreach of Horry County on July 31 st . They were thrilled to see all the beautiful quilts. Lots of oohs and aahs!! **Thank you in advance for all your help!**

August 19th Workshop Doors Open @ 9 a.m.: **No Machines Required!** Since we were able to get much of the charity work done in July we've got 2 jobs in August, neither requiring a sewing machine! We have only 35 or so bead bags to finish cording which shouldn't take too long. The other bigger project we'll be working on is making favors for the 2025 Meet the Quilter. We're turning Karen Fedor's donation of beautiful batiks into fat quarters (about 600 FQS!!) and then into star bundles. So, this month we need cutters, pressers and folders. Bring your basic sewing kits, scissors, etc and come join in the fun. Did I mention.... goodies will be served!!

What to bring:

Cutters: cutting mat, rotary cutter and 6 ½" x 24" ruler

Pressers: ironing pad, travel iron (like a mini Oliso or other travel iron) and Best Press.

We also have some irons and ironing boards at OSV, but thought the ironed pads and travel irons would be easier.... can sit down to press.

Folders: check out the YouTube video by Rebecca Mae Designs on how to fold fat quarters into star bundles. Maggie Ogniek knows the drill and will be able to guide us thru that process.

Thank you, Joyce Jaret! Joyce received a huge donation of beautiful ribbons and cording too. The timing couldn't have been more perfect! At this point we are unsure if we'll actually get to making the star bundles phase...we'll just have to see how this all goes. But anyway, we get to play with fabric...so it's sure to be lots of fun!!

Baby Quilts and Homespun kits: Please return all remaining baby quilts that were finished at home and all the boys' homespun kits as well. Our plan is to spray baste all the homespun tops in Nov. but we'll need to cut backing, batting and bindings before that too.

Quilters Needed: Back to school is a very busy time for Fostering Hope. Once the teachers get eyes on the children sadly more and more are taken into foster care. It's the unfortunate reality of the situation. In the storage unit right now, we have still have 7 quilts ready for longarmers and about the same number of spray basted quilts ready for quilting. We would like to get those done and out of there because we have lots of tops returned that need batting cut. We like to keep the pipeline filled so Fostering Hope has a continuous flow of quilts coming in. And to do that we need your help!
