

The <u>doors will open at 8:30</u> , sewers please <u>be set up and ready to go at 9 a.m</u> .
Sewers of baby quilts: please bring the following
$_{\square}$ Sewing machine with a walking foot and decorative stitches, if possible. Also, it
is extremely helpful if you can adjust the downward pressure of your presser foot
especially when sewing the flannel quilts. Please check your manual if you're not
aware of this feature.
□ Extension table for your machine is very helpful
□ Extension cord and/or multiplug
□ Spare machine needles (in case you break one)
□ Quilting glove: it's helpful, if you have one.
$\hfill\square$ Threads: neutrals (white, grey, off white). We'll bring some colors for topstitching.
□ Basic sewing kit: scissors, pins, seam ripper, etc.
Turners: bring a bodkin to help smooth out the seams, scissors and seam ripper.
Pressers: bring a mister if you have one. We have several ironing boards and irons.
Bead bags: bring scissors and a bodkin, if you have one. We do have some bodkins.
Also remember to bring a snack or lunch and a drink. Everyone will be treated to ice
cream sundaes and cookies. We all scream for ice cream! Yay!
